

## End of Production (EOP) Notice – April 2003

### AFFECTED PRODUCTS

Alacritech Server and Storage Accelerator Driver for Windows NT4 Environments.

### DESCRIPTION

The upcoming driver release of 5.5.1.x will be the last version to support Windows NT 4.0 Service Pack (SP) 6. Effective with the release of driver 5.5.1.x, Alacritech will discontinue production of Server and Storage Accelerator Driver on the Windows NT 4.0 SP 6 platform.

### Windows NT 4.0 SP 6 End Of Production – April 2003; End Of Support – December 2004

Alacritech Technical Support will continue to provide full support, including programmatic corrections to errors for the Windows NT4 SP 6 platform, until December 31, 2003. Beginning January 1, 2004 Alacritech Technical Support will continue to provide technical assistance and make reasonable efforts to provide workarounds for problems with Server and Storage Accelerator Driver on the Windows NT 4.0 SP 6 platform until December 31, 2004. However, beginning January 1, 2004 we will not provide programmatic corrections to errors for this platform.

### MIGRATION PATH

The current version Server and Storage Accelerator Driver (5.5.0) is still fully supported on Windows NT 4.0 SP 6, and the 5.x series of drivers are available from our website at <http://www.alacritech.com/html/techsupport.html>

Our intention with this notice is to allow our customers adequate time to plan and implement migration of their computers to supported operating environments with minimal impact.
